Eβρ 4:14-16, 5:1-6 Heb. 4:14-16; 5:1-6

Άδελφοί, ἔχοντες άρχιερέα μέγαν διεληλυθότα τοὺς οὐρανούς, Ίησοῦν τὸν υἱὸν τοῦ Θεοῦ, κρατῶμεν τῆς ομολογίας, οὐ γὰρ ἔχομεν ἀρχιερέα μὴ δυνάμενον συμπαθῆσαι ταῖς ἀσθενείαις ἡμῶν, πεπειραμένον δὲ κατὰ πάντα καθ' ὁμοιότητα χωρὶς ἁμαρτίας. προσερχώμεθα οὖν μετὰ παρρησίας τῶ θρόνω τῆς χάριτος, ἵνα λάβωμεν ἔλεον καὶ χάριν εὕρωμεν είς εὔκαιρον βοήθειαν. Πᾶς γὰρ ἀρχιερεὺς έξ άνθρώπων λαμβανόμενος ὑπὲρ ἀνθρώπων καθίσταται τὰ πρὸς τὸν Θεόν, ἵνα προσφέρη δῶρά τε καὶ θυσίας ὑπὲρ άμαρτιῶν, μετριοπαθεῖν δυνάμενος τοῖς ἀγνοοῦσι καὶ πλανωμένοις, ἐπεὶ καὶ αὐτὸς περίκειται ἀσθένειαν· καὶ διὰ ταύτην όφείλει, καθώς περὶ τοῦ λαοῦ, οὕτω καὶ περὶ έαυτοῦ προσφέρειν ὑπὲρ άμαρτιῶν. καὶ οὐχ ἑαυτῷ τις λαμβάνει τὴν τιμήν, άλλὰ καλούμενος ὑπὸ τοῦ Θεοῦ, καθάπερ καὶ Άαρών. οὕτω καὶ ὁ Χριστὸς οὐχ ἑαυτὸν ἐδόξασε γενηθῆναι ἀρχιερέα, ἀλλ' ο λαλήσας προς αὐτόν. υἱός μου εἶ σύ, ἐγὼ σήμερον γεγέννηκά σε· καθώς καὶ ἐν ἑτέρω λέγει· σὺ ίερεὺς εἰς τὸν αἰῶνα κατὰ τὴν τάξιν Μελχισεδέκ.

Brethren, since we have a high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we have not a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. For every high priest chosen from among men is appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He can deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is beset with weakness. Because of this he is bound to offer sacrifice for his own sins as well as for those of the people. And one does not take the honor upon himself, but he is called by God, just as Aaron was. So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"; as he says also in another place, "You are a priest for ever, after the order of Melchizedek."

And he said to them, "Truly, I say to you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the kingdom of God come with power."


