

#### Pωμ 10:11 – 21; 11:1 – 2

Άδελφοί, λέγει ἡ γραφή πᾶς ο πιστεύων έπὶ τῶ Θεῶ οὐ καταισχυνθήσεται. οὐ γὰρ ἔστι διαστολὴ Ἰουδαίου τε καὶ Έλληνος ὁ γὰρ αὐτὸς Κύριος πάντων, πλουτῶν εἰς πάντας τοὺς ἐπικαλουμένους αὐτόν. πᾶς γὰρ ὃς ἂν ἐπικαλέσηται τὸ ὄνομα Κυρίου σωθήσεται. πῶς οὖν ἐπικαλέσονται εἰς ὃν ούκ ἐπίστευσαν; πῶς δὲ πιστεύσουσιν οὖ οὐκ ἤκουσαν: πῶς δὲ ἀκούσουσι χωρὶς κηρύσσοντος; πῶς δὲ κηρύξουσιν έὰν μὴ ἀποσταλῶσι; καθὼς γέγρα-εύαγγελίζομένων εἰρήνην, τῶν εὐαγγελιζομένων τὰ άγαθά! Άλλ' οὐ πάντες ὑπήκουσαν τῷ εὐαγγελίω. Ήσαΐας γὰρ λέγει· Κύριε, τίς ἐπίστευσε τῆ ἀκοῆ ἡμῶν; ἄρα ἡ πίστις ἐξ ἀκοῆς, ἡ δὲ ἀκοὴ διὰ ῥήματος Θεοῦ. ἀλλὰ λέγω, μὴ οὐκ ἤκουσαν; μενοῦνγε εἰς πᾶσαν τὴν γῆν έξῆλθεν ὁ φθόγγος αὐτῶν, καὶ εἰς τὰ πέρατα τῆς οἰκουμένης τὰ ῥήματα αὐτῶν. άλλὰ λέγω, μὴ οὐκ ἔγνω Ίσραήλ; πρῶτος Μωϋσῆς λένει ένὼ παραζηλώσω ὑμᾶς έπ' οὐκ ἔθνει, έπὶ ἔθνει άσυνέτω παροργιῶ ὑμᾶς. Ήσαΐας δὲ ἀποτολμᾶ καὶ λέγει ευρέθην τοῖς ἐμὲ μὴ ζητοῦσιν, ἐμφανὴς ἐγενόμην τοῖς ἐμὲ μὴ ἐπερωτῶσι. πρὸς δὲ τὸν Ἰσραὴλ λέγει ὅλην τὴν ἡμέραν έξεπέτασα τὰς χεῖράς μου πρὸς λαὸν ἀπειθοῦντα καὶ ἀντιλέγοντα. Λέγω οὖν, μὴ ἀπώσατο ὁ Θεὸς τὸν λαὸν αὐτοῦ; μὴ γένοιτο· καὶ γὰρ έγω Ίσραηλίτης εἰμί, ἐκ σπέρματος Άβραάμ, φυλῆς Βενιαμίν. οὐκ ἀπώσατο ὁ Θεὸς τὸν λαὸν αὐτοῦ ὃν προέγνω.

#### Rom. 10:11 – 21; MT 9:9 – 13 11:1 – 2

Brethren, the scripture says, "No one who believes in God will be put to shame." For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all and bestows his riches upon all who call upon him. For, "every one who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved." But how are men to call upon him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without a preacher? And how can men preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach good news!" But they have not all obeyed the gospel; for Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?" So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes by the preaching of Christ. But I ask, have they not heard? Indeed they have; for "Their voice has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world." Again I ask, did Israel not understand? First Moses says, "I will make you jealous of those who are not a nation: with a foolish nation I will make you angry." Then Isaiah is so bold as to say, "I have been found by those who did not seek me; I have shown myself to those who did not ask for me." But of Israel he says, "All day long I have held out my hands to a disobedient and contrary people." I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin. God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew.

#### Mt. 9:9 - 13

At that time, as Jesus was walking along, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax office; and he said to him. "Follow me." And he rose and followed him. And as he sat at table in the house, behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Jesus and his disciples. And when the Pharisees saw this. they said to his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" But when he heard it, he said. "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. Go and learn what this means, 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice.' For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

Unassailed by Hades, You divested it of spoils. Then You met the Virgin. You granted life. O Lord, risen from the dead, glory to You!

O holy Apostle and Evangelist Matthew, make intercession to our merciful God, that He grant our souls forgiveness of offenses.

### Kontakion. Mode 4. You who were lifted.

The Savior's most pure and immaculate temple, the very precious bridal chamber and Virgin, who is the sacred treasure of the glory of God, on this day is introduced into the House of the Lord, and with herself she brings the grace in the divine Spirit. She is extolled by the Angels of God. A heavenly tabernacle is she.
